This cause came before the Court on June 24, 1980, upon a petition for review, defendant's answer thereto, the record of proceedings before the Commission, and was argued by counsel. In consideration whereof the Court is of the opinion that the Commission's findings as to the facts are supported by evidence in the record. Moreover, the Commission properly ruled that the plaintiff was not available for work during a week in which his search for work consisted of two telephone calls to employers and one telephone call to his union. (underscoring supplied)
